OVERALL JOB PURPOSE

• The field officer will be employed to assist with carrying out the "Smart Discharge" study. This process includes assisting the research nurse with consenting and enrolling participants, conducting surveys of the child and their caregiver, and conducting follow-up surveys after hospital discharge by phone or in-person by traveling to the participant's home in the community. The field officer will work closely with a site-based research team, as well as the project team, based at Bugando Medical Centre (BMC)

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND COMPETENCIES

- Minimum qualification; Certificate or Diploma Nurse registered with the TANZANIA NURSING AND MIDWIFERY COUNCIL - TNMC.
- Must hold a valid practicing license.
- Strong problem-solving and decision-making skills.

- Good interpersonal skills and knowledge of practices, trends and principles in nursing and Quality of care.
- Familiarity with the healthcare system and research practices.

- Able and willing to ride a motorcycle and travel to participants in the community.
- Have a valid driving license clearly indicating Class A.

SPECIFIC JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Collection of all data on the ward during hospitalization and by phone or in-person at the child's home after discharge.
- 2. Ensuring safety and confidentiality of the data collected
- 3. Work hand in hand with the Smart Discharges research nurse team and the child's clinical team, to ensure accurate sharing of data, consistent quality in data collection and seamless clinical and research activities.
- 4. Upholding high level of professional conduct
- 5. Assist with data entry, organization, and upkeep of databases
- 6. Work hand in hand with the Study Coordinator and PI to ensure accuracy and completeness of the data collected.
- 7. Upholding high level of professional conduct.
- 8. Any other duties as assigned.
